Now, God has reignited our passion for this community, and we believe that this mission is not just about the people we'll serve, but about growing a missional heart within each of us at New Hope. Over the past year we have been visiting, in prayer, and consideration and God has been pushing us in this direction.

The challenges faced by the San Carlos Apache Nation are immense—high poverty, rampant substance abuse, and an overwhelming need for housing and hope. But we also believe in a God of transformation, who is calling us to step in and be a light. This mission trip is more than just an opportunity to help with prayer journeys and light construction; it's a chance to be the hands and feet of Jesus in a place where His light is desperately needed.

Our hope is that as we serve this community, we too will be changed—that God will use this trip to cultivate within us a deeper understanding of what it means to live out the Great Commission. We believe that by stepping into this work, you'll come back not just with stories of what God did through you, but with a renewed passion for what He's doing in and through our church.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. WHAT ARE THE ACCOMMODATIONS LIKE?

We will be staying in group housing provided by Arizona Reservation Ministries (ARM). The accommodations include bunk beds, separate bathrooms, and communal meals. You'll need to bring sleeping bags, pillows, towels, and personal toiletries unless otherwise arranged. Meals will be provided from Friday dinner to Monday lunch.

2. HOW ARE WE GETTING THERE?

We'll be traveling together by rented van and trailer, ensuring everyone is together and that we can transport tools and supplies efficiently.

3. WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

We will participate in prayer journeys and light construction work on Saturday and Sunday. On Monday morning, we'll continue with construction before departing by noon.

4. WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Bring work gloves, sunscreen, sturdy shoes, a hat, water bottles, and comfortable clothing suitable for light construction. Arizona Reservation Ministries encourages modest clothing to respect the local culture. You will also need a sleeping bag, pillow, towels, and personal toiletries.

5. WHO CAN GO ON THIS TRIP?

This trip is open to up to 30 people. We encourage all church members to prayerfully consider joining, whether as individuals, families, or groups. Anyone over 13+ years old are welcome to join.

6. WHEN IS THE ORIENTATION MEETING?

We'll have an orientation team meeting on December 8th, after service. This is a great opportunity to get all the details, ask questions, and prepare spiritually and practically for the trip.

7. WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE COST?

The total cost of \$320 per person covers all meals, accommodations, and transportation for the trip. A \$50 deposit is required to secure your spot, with the balance due by January 19th, 2024.

8. IS THIS TRIP APPROPRIATE FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES?

Yes, families are welcome to attend, but due to the nature of the work, it may be best suited for teens and adults. If families with younger children wish to participate, there will be specific guidelines discussed at the December 8th orientation meeting.

9. WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM THE MISSION WORK?

Expect to participate in both practical work and spiritual outreach. This includes construction tasks to improve living conditions and prayer journeys that connect us with the community and God's mission for the San Carlos Apache Nation. Every aspect of the trip is designed to bring hope and light to a community in need, while also deepening our faith.

10. HOW DOES THIS TRIP FIT INTO NEW HOPE'S VISION?

This mission trip reflects our church's heart for living out the Great Commission. As we serve others, God will also be working within us, helping to grow a missional mindset that can shape our outreach and ministry efforts at home.
